Innovation financing to support solar irrigation

- Financing as a major barrier to promote solar irrigation
- Need for public funding in supporting solar irrigation
- Offgrid solar companies require equity, debt, and grant financing for a range of purposes at different stages of their growth, and all have significant working capital needs
- Six principles to maximize the chance of success of public funding schemes:
 - Target resources to the people most in need.
 - Support good-quality products.
 - Provide support commensurate with need for closing the financing and affordability gaps.
 - o Provide funding in an efficient and timely manner.
 - Effectively verify program results.
 - Promote sustainable results.
- Combination of supply-side mechanisms (upfront grants results-based financing, tax exemptions, credit lines and risk mitigation) and demand-side mechanisms (demand-side subsidies, public procurement)
- The combination depends on the objectives of the program, market characteristics, the time available, and the implementing capacity of the lead agency as well as any potential partners
